About the Project

SIEMdig is a European project co-funded by the European Commission under the Erasmus+ KA220-SCH Program. Running from December 1, 2023, to November 30, 2025, and is coordinated by the University of the National Education Commission in Krakow, Poland. The project aims to innovate primary education through digital tools, empathy, and community engagement, empowering teachers to enhance their digital skills and integrate digital content effectively.

Project Objectives



Supporting Teachers: Equip primary school educators with digital tools and training to enhance their digital skills and teaching methods.

Fostering Empathy: Promote acceptance among pupils through digital storytelling that highlights real-life challenges of disadvantaged individuals.

Community Engagement: Bridge schools and communities to foster inclusion and support for all children.

Digital Resources: A repository for teachers to integrate dynamic digital content into lessons.

Storytelling Platform: Interactive narratives with teaching rubrics to encourage empathy.

Inclusion Guide: A resource for schools and communities to cultivate acceptance and inclusivity.

Teacher Training: Programs to effectively use the storytelling platform in classrooms.























Digital Tools Collection


