SIEMdig Concludes with Final Meeting and LTTA in Cyprus: Empowering Teachers Through Digital Inclusion

The Erasmus+ project SIEMdig - Social Inclusion and Emotional Maturity of the Society's youngest participants helped by digitally competent teachers has successfully concluded its journey, marking its final stages with the Final Transnational Project Meeting (TPM) and the Learning, Teaching, and Training Activity (LTTA) held in Nicosia, Cyprus, in September 2025.

The events were **hosted by the THALES Foundation**, bringing together representatives from all partner organisations to reflect on the project's achievements, exchange experiences, and explore ways to sustain its impact beyond the project's lifetime.

Final TPM & LTTA Highlights

During the **Final TPM**, partners discussed the overall progress, evaluation outcomes, and long-term sustainability of the SIEMdig results. The **LTTA** provided hands-on training for educators, focusing on the **SIEMdig Teacher Training Modules** and practical implementation of the project's digital tools. Teachers participated in interactive sessions designed to:

- Integrate digital storytelling into inclusive education
- Enhance empathy and emotional intelligence in young learners
- Promote collaboration with families and communities through technology.

This event served as a meaningful conclusion to the SIEMdig journey, celebrating collaboration, innovation, and inclusion.
